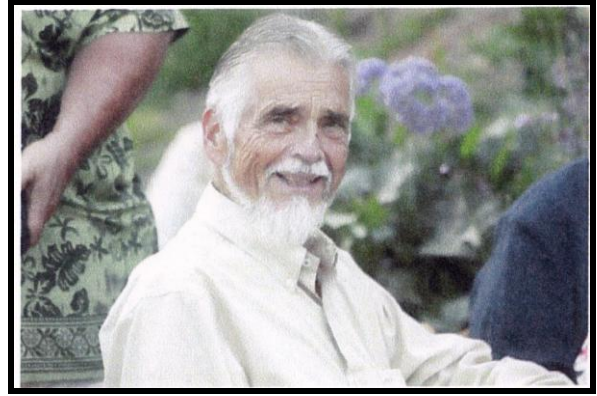
### Beach Fun Day
