

THE KIWANIS CLUB OF OCEANSIDE PACIFIC

Since you have indicated an interest in the Kiwanis Club of Oceanside Pacific, let us tell you a few things about our club, how it operates and who we are. More information about Kiwanis International is available from our Club Secretary. Since each club tends to have its own “personality,” this brochure illustrates the things which make us unique.

Our club is the newest Kiwanis Club in Oceanside. We were organized on February 24, 1981. Each Wednesday morning, we meet for breakfast and our regular meeting. This occurs at the HomeTown Buffet, 491 College Blvd., in Oceanside. The meetings begin at 7:00 a.m. and end by 8:15.

WHAT DO WE DO?

Kiwanis Clubs serve the communities in which they are located by participating in a variety of service projects. A general focus is through a program called “Young Children: Priority One.” We pay special attention to those youngsters who are disadvantaged.

All of our projects are developed through a committee structure common to all Kiwanis Clubs.

Our motto, “We Build,” sets the underlying tone for our efforts.

We meet for breakfast, some club business and a program each week. During these times, we form enduring friendships with people we might never meet but for Kiwanis.

CLUB EXPECTATIONS

Each member is expected to attend the regular weekly meetings and to participate in the club projects to the extent possible. Members make up meetings they miss in a variety of ways.

WHAT DOES IT COST?

An Application Fee of \$50.00 accompanies a Proposal for Membership. It is used to process the new member with the Kiwanis International organization. Dues are \$185.00 per year, payable in one or two installments. Other funds are collected through the raffle and “happy” or “sad” dollars. You will see this in action during the meeting.

HOW DO I JOIN?

You must be sponsored by an active member and approved by our Board of Directors. Your sponsor can assist you with the application process.

Upon approval by the Board and payment of the Application Fee, you will be ready for induction as a new member. You will be billed for a pro rata share of the Annual Dues.

THE PRESIDENT’S INVITATION

A person joins a service club due to a desire to improve the community through service projects. More can be accomplished as a member of an active group than as an individual.
